

TITLE:

RESIDENCE DISCIPLINE AND DISHONESTY

(Relates to EL-7: Treatment of Students) (Relates to EL-18: Participation of Students)

EFFECTIVE DATE: March 1, 2004

PURPOSE:

To identify expectations related to conduct within the Residences and to provide a fair process to deal with violations.

POLICY STATEMENT:

Each tenant, by action of signing the Residence Rental Agreement, agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of the Residence.

In the event that a tenant is suspected of dishonesty or misconduct as outlined in the Residence Handbook, the Family Handbook and/or the Rental Agreement, he/she may be subject to disciplinary action.

Anyone who witnesses an occurrence of tenant misconduct should report it to the Residence Manager, the Residence Life Coordinator, a Resident Assistant, or a Commissionaire.

It is understood that the Residence Discipline and Dishonesty Policy would not supersede any criminal proceedings which would be dealt with through the police.
